- The judges' decision is final – any objection must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the class with a £20.00 deposit (deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld).
- The organisers reserve the right to amend / amalgamate classes or split as necessary.
- All dogs must be kept on a lead, owners to carry bags and remove any mess.
- All litter must be taken home with you or placed in bins provided.
